Winnipeg Beach Day Camp Volunteer Code of Conduct

At Winnipeg Beach Day Camp we strive to provide a safe, fun respectful environment for all campers, parents, volunteers and staff. We believe that everyone has the right to have an excellent camp experience, and as such we have a zero tolerance policy towards violence, bullying and harassment.

As volunteers your children will have an integral role to play in making the camp experience positive for other volunteers and campers. They must understand that while they are here to have a fun and rewarding experience, their role is to work with and take direction from camp staff and to ensure that the needs of campers are met.

Your child must:

- Be able to take instruction and follow directions from camp staff.
- Maintain and project a positive image of the camp, camp activities and camp staff.
- Be patient, positive and caring towards campers.
- Not behave in a manner that negatively affects the experiences of campers, other volunteers or staff.
- Respect Winnipeg Beach Day Camp and all camp property and the belongings and property of other campers, volunteers and staff.
- These guidelines are for the protection and benefit of all. Violations can result in immediate removal from camp.

Unacceptable Behavior will not be tolerated.

Some examples of inappropriate behavior include:

- Leaving your camp post without informing a supervising member of camp staff to obtain permission. (This could be dangerous to yourself or to the campers).
- Threatening behavior, bullying offensive or insulting language, verbal or physical abuse towards campers, staff, other volunteers of guests.
- Being in possession of any type of weapon or implement that staff deem to be dangerous or potentially dangerous.
- Any illegal activity.
